CALL TO The meeting was called to order at 5:35p.m. By Chairperson Bert Other Bull

STDNT.1 Due to the individuals right to privacy exceeds the public’s right to know, Board Chair Other Bull called for an executive session at 5:37 p.m. to hear student one (1) expulsion issue.

The Board Chair reopened the meeting at 6:35 p.m.

Anderson moved and Limberhand seconded to expel C.B.H student one for the rest of the semester. She will be allowed to join 2011 summer school and will be allowed to enroll in the school next school year (2011-12). Beartusk, Limberhand, Other Bull, Anderson and White Crane approved. Headswift and Knobloch abstained.
